Q and A Forum

We will have both a panel and a facilitator for the forum. The panel will consist of us, the Skillman elders, David Meyer, executive minister of The Hills, and John Willbanks, elder at The Hills.

We are pleased to announce that Jon Mullican will facilitate the session. Mr. Mullican brings more than 30 years of leadership experience in a variety of environments, including facilitating critical conversations that involve multiple perspectives. He is principal of the Mullican Leadership Group and HOPE Network Ministries, and he has supported more than 100 churches in various ways through coaching, group facilitation, team development, and leadership development. In addition, Mr. Mullican has served as Executive Minister at the Highland Oaks Church of Christ in Dallas and has served as adjunct faculty at Pepperdine University.

Q and A Forum Guidelines

In the interest of ensuring that we use our time advantageously, we are providing guidelines for the forum:

1. This is a Q and A forum and not a general discussion. Our intention is to provide as much information as possible to the members through an orderly process.
2. Mr. Mullican will begin the forum with questions that have already been submitted to the elders and then move to questions submitted at the meeting.
3. We will provide note cards and pens/pencils to members. We ask that you write your questions down, so that Mr. Mullican can clearly and accurately read them to the panel. You may choose to sign your name or submit questions anonymously.
4. Members attending via Zoom can submit questions that will be written down and given to Mr. Mullican.
5. The time allotted for the meeting is from 9 a.m. to 10:15 a.m. Mr. Mullican will stop the meeting at 10:05 a.m. and summarize the next steps in the exploratory process.
6. We will close our Q and A forum with prayer.

Remember to give our brothers and sisters in Christ grace, as grace has been given to each one of us. We will have differing questions and emphasis on various aspects of exploring the possibility of joining with The Hills. We encourage you to be patient with each other, and as elders, we ask that you continue to pray to discern God's will for Skillman Church of Christ.
